RESOLUTION NO. 158

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY AMENDING THE

FINANCIAL AUTHORITY PARAMETERS FOR THE VALLEY

REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY FIRE CHIEF/ADMINISTRATOR

WHEREAS, the Valley Regional Fire Authority (Authority) is a political

subdivision of the State of Washington, created and established pursuant to Chapter

52.26 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW); and

WHEREAS, the Valley Regional Fire Authority (VRFA) has financial

obligations and has resources available to it currently as provided through tax and

fee revenues, intended to meet its operational needs; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the operations of the VRFA and the

administrative duties of the VRFA Fire Chief/Administrator, the Board of Governance

previously adopted Resolution No. 15 establishing financial authority parameters;

and

WHEREAS, in order for the Fire Chief/Administrator to be able to enter into

and implement contracts and meet obligations of the authority, it is appropriate that

the dollar amount identified in Resolution No. 15, under which review by the

Governance Board is not required, be increased from the current threshold of

\$25,000, to \$50,000.

NOW THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY

REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Fire Chief/Administrator of the VRFA has a threshold

authority to enter into contracts or incur obligations in connection with the operations

and needs of the VRFA in an amount up to \$50,000 and/or in an amount

corresponding to existing contracts and obligations that are specifically and expressly

approved in the budget process. Obligations in excess of these standards shall be

reviewed and approved by the VRFA Board of Governance.

Section 2. That VRFA Policy No. 2200, Financial Management, be updated

with this new threshold.

Section 3. Administrative Authorization. The Fire Chief/Administrator of the

Authority is hereby authorized to implement such administrative procedures as may

be necessary to carry out this directive.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect

upon passage and signatures hereon.
