MINUTES

I. CALL TO ORDER, 5:00 P.M., 1101 D Street NE, AUBURN, WASHINGTON Chair Lynda Osborn called the VRFA Finance Committee Regular Meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

II. AGENDA MODIFICATIONS

Chief Swearingen stated that Resolution 157 Retirement Medical was being removed from consideration.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

A. Minutes

Minutes of the February 11, 2020 Regular Meeting were reviewed.

There being no questions or discussion, Member Storaasli moved and Chair Osborn seconded to approve the Minutes of the February 11, 2020 regular meeting.

A. Vouchers

1. Claims

A. Resolution 157 Retirement Medical

B. Resolution 158 Spending Authority

Chief Swearingen stated Resolution 158 is a replacement resolution of current resolution number 15 which establishes maximum discretionary limits on the Fire Chief of the VRFA. This resolution would increase the spending authority to \$50,000, which is in line with other agency leaders.

There being no questions or discussion, Member Storaasli moved and Chair Osborn seconded to recommend approval of the Spending Authority by the Board of Governance.

C. Governance Bylaws Update

Chief Swearingen stated the governance bylaws and rules have become, in part, outdated. This resolution would bring the bylaws into compliance with all current laws and practices of the governing body.

There being no questions or discussion, Member Storaasli moved and Chair Osborn seconded to recommend approval of the Governance Bylaws update by the Board of Governance.

D. King County BLS Service Agreement

Deputy Chief Larberg stated the BLS Service Agreement is to set terms and dollar allocation rates in support of the VRFA's Basic Life Support services. The terms of this agreement reflect the recently approved KC EMS Levy.

There being no questions or discussion, Member Storaasli moved and Chair Osborn seconded to recommend approval of the BLS Service Agreement by the Board of Governance.
