



HOW TO LOOK-UP YOUR PROPERTY'S **FIRE JURISDICTION**

King County

1. Go to: https://www5.kingcounty.gov/KCGISReports/dd_report.aspx

OR manually navigate to the **King County GIS Districts & Development Conditions Report** page on kingcounty.gov
King County » Services » King County GIS Center » Property Research » Conditions Report

2. Enter your property's address or parcel # (format example: "1101 D St NE")

3. On the property data page, look under the header that says: **KING COUNTY ELECTORAL DISTRICTS**

4. You will find the **FIRE DISTRICT** or **REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY DISTRICT** for your property

Pierce County

1. Go to: <https://pals.piercecountywa.gov/palsonline/#/AboutMyProperty>

OR manually navigate to the **Department of Assessments** page on co.pierce.wa.us
Pierce County » Doing Business » Parcel Search » External Links » About My Property

2. Enter your property's address or parcel # (format example: "500 182ND AVE E")

3. On the property data page, click on the header that says: **ABOUT MY PROPERTY**

4. If the **FIRE DISTRICT** is labeled: "**City of Auburn**", your property is serviced by the Valley Regional Fire Authority
