A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ELECTRONIC EMERGENCY KEY BOX EQUIPMENT UTILIZING SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT

WHEREAS, the Valley Regional Fire Authority (Authority) desires to purchase electronic emergency key box equipment to be deployed within the Authority's service area; and

WHEREAS, the Authority budgeted for the procurement and implementation of such equipment in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has reviewed electronic lock systems for use by public safety organizations and determined that Knox Company, the sole vendor of the product, best suits the need of the Authority; and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280 Competitive Bidding Requirements – Exemptions allows for the Authority to purchase through a sole source vendor;

NOW THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY
REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Electronic Lock equipment shall be purchased from Knox Company, a Phoenix AZ based company specializing in emergency key box systems for fire and EMS agencies.

<u>Section 2.</u> Unless otherwise specified in this resolution, if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to
