RESOLUTION NO. 171

A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A

TEMPORARY INTERFUND LOAN

WHEREAS, the Valley Regional Fire Authority (Authority) is a political

subdivision of the State of Washington, created and established pursuant to Chapter

52.26 of the Revised Code of Washington (RCW); and

WHEREAS, the Authority receives impact fees collected on its behalf by the

City of Auburn; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn must amend its current budget prior to

remitting impact fee funds to the Authority; and

WHEREAS, because of the present delay in receipt of these funds, the

Authority will not have sufficient funds in the Capital Project Fund to remit the down

payment for the purchase of an aerial apparatus; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board that a temporary interfund loan from

the General Fund (Fund Number 001) to the Capital Projects Fund (Fund Number

301) is necessary to fund the down payment for the purchase of an aerial apparatus

to serve the residents of the Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY

REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Resolution No. 171

Section 1. A temporary interfund loan of up to \$580,000 be allowed from

the General Fund to the Capital Projects Fund to be used for the down payment for

the purchase of an aerial apparatus.

Section 2. The transfer shall be accounted for as a temporary borrowing

between funds in accordance with the Washington State Auditor's BARS Manual for

cash basis entities.

Section 3. The amount borrowed by the Capital Projects Fund shall be paid

back to the General Fund as soon as sufficient monies are available, but no later

than the following fiscal year. Repayment shall include the amount of interest that

the General Fund would have otherwise earned from its investments in the Local

Government Investment Pool.

Section 4. Unless otherwise specified in this resolution, if any section,

subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to

be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the

validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of the Resolution.

Section 5. Administrative Authorization. The Fire Chief/Administrator and

Chief Financial Officer of the Authority are hereby authorized to implement such

administrative procedures as may be necessary to carry out this directive.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect

upon passage and signatures hereon.
