This is a one-time increase to the number of available slots spelled out in the VRFA Policy 2138 Retirement Medical Benefit due to the COVID-19 vaccine mandate as a condition of employment.

There being no further discussion or questions, Member Brown moved and Member Storassli seconded the adoption of the Retirement Medical Benefit Adjustment.
