
AMMO & FIREWORKS DISPOSAL

As a public safety organization, the VRFA assists the public with properly disposing of consumer fireworks and small arms ammunition, emphasizing the safe transfer and handling of such materials. The following guide outlines VRFA receivable materials and items that require disposal at another facility.

The VRFA can accept the following materials for disposal purposes:







FIREWORKS, LEGAL CONSUMER GRADE STAMPED 1.4G

If fireworks appear questionable or packaging is unclear, do not deliver it to the VRFA.



Examples of consumer grade fireworks: fountains (cylindrical or cone), helicopters/aerial spinners, ground spinners, smoke devices, sparklers.



AMMO & FIREWORKS DISPOSAL

DO NOT touch, move, breathe, do anything near explosives that are crystallized, weeping or, possibly appear to be unstable. Call 911 if in doubt and leave the area.



The VRFA will NOT accept the following materials for disposal purposes:







FIREWORKS, COMMERCIAL **GRADE STAMPED 1.3G** If fireworks appear questionable or packaging is unclear, do not deliver it



BLASTING CAPS OR DETONATORS



LOOSE PYROTECHNIC OR FLASH POWDER

Or any black/smokeless powder NOT in it's original packaging





ARMOR-PIERCING OR TRACERS
