"Hofschulte v. King County Fire Chiefs Association et al.", King County Superior

Court #21-2-14749-2 SEA, arising out of his actions as Fire Chief of VRFA;

NOW THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE VALLEY

REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Fire Chief of the VRFA, Brad Thompson, shall be and

is provided a defense and indemnification by his Employer, the Valley Regional Fire

Authority, in the above-entitled action, irrespective of the determination of the

Washington Cities Insurance Authority, as to coverage by WCIA for this litigation.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect

upon passage and signatures hereon.
