

Requirements Met at Learning Stations: Girl and Boy Scouts

The following outlines requirements met at our learning stations. In some cases, the requirement isn't complete at the Scout Night event but the scout will take home the knowledge to complete the requirement on their own time.

Home Safety

Tiger	Safe & Smart Requirement 5 – Show you can stop, drop & roll
Tiger	Safe & Smart Requirement 5 – Check batteries in smoke alarm
Webelos	Fix it Requirement 4Q – Change the battery in a smoke alarm or carbon monoxide alarm and test its operation.
Webelos	Project Family Requirement 6 – Inspect your home & its surroundings. Make a list of hazards or security problems you find, correct one.
Daisy	Safety Award – Find out how a smoke alarm works
Brownie	Safety Award – Find out how a smoke alarm works, test the one at your home so you know what it sounds like and to make sure it works.
Junior	Safety Award – Do a home safety audit to check for dangers around the house.

Basic First Aid

Webelos	First Responder Requirement 1 – Explain what first aid is. Tell what you should do after an accident.
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 2 – Show what to do for serious bleeding, stopped breathing, poisoning, and heart attack/cardiac arrest.
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 3 – Show how to help a choking person
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 4 – Show how to treat shock
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 5 – Show first aid for cuts, scratches, burns, scalds, choking, blisters, tick bites, bites and stings, nosebleed, poisonous snake bite, frostbite, sunburn.
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 6 – Explain how to use each item in a first aid kit.
Brownie	Legacy First Aid – Talk to someone who treats injured people, make a first aid kit, learn how to treat minor injuries, know how to treat outdoor injuries
Junior	Legacy First Aid – Talk to first responders, learn the first steps to take in an emergency, make a portable first aid kit, find out how to handle urgent first aid issues, know how to take care of someone who is sick.
Cadette	Legacy First Aid – Understand how to care for younger children, know how to use everything in a first aid kit, know how to recognize and treat shock, know how to treat outdoor injuries and injuries due to weather

Automated External Defibrillators (AED's) /Cardiac Arrest/Stroke

Webelos	First Responder Requirement 2 – Show what to do for the “hurry cases” of first aid: heart attack or sudden cardiac arrest, defibrillation, stopped breathing, stroke
Cadette	Legacy First Aid – Careers to Explore (Emergency Medical Technician, Paramedic)

Home Escape Planning

Tiger	Safe & Smart Requirement 3 – Make a fire escape map
Tiger	Requirement 4 – Explain your fire escape map and try a practice fire drill at home
Webelos	First Responder Requirement 7 – Create and practice an emergency readiness plan for our home or den meeting place.
Junior	Safety Award – Conduct an emergency evacuation drill of your home. In case of fire, know where the exit is located and plan alternate ways to escape.

Emergency Preparedness

Wolf	Call of the Wild Requirement 5 – Show what to do in case of a natural disaster such as an earthquake or flood.
Webelos	Camper Requirement 3– Actions you should take in case of extreme weather events which could require you to evacuate.
Brownie	Safety Award – Find out what natural disasters are most common in your area. Philanthropist-Know how to help in times of emergency (fire, floods, earthquake, tornados, etc.)

Firefighter Tools, Equipment and Careers

Tiger	Safe & Smart Requirement 6 – Visit a fire station
Wolf	Council Fire Requirement 5 – Talk to a Firefighter about their service to the community
Webelo	First Responder Requirement 8 – Visit with a first responder
Daisy	Sunny’s Story 3 – Visit a community helper at their job, ask them to talk about what they do. Gerry’s Story Find out about people who are authorities in your community
Cadette	Legacy First Aid – Careers to explore (Emergency Medical Technician)

Ropes and Knots

Bear	Bear Necessities Requirement 8 – Tie two half hitches and explain what the hitch is used for.
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Wolf	Call of the Wild Requirement 2 – Show how to tie an overhand knot and a square knot.
Webelos	Scouting Adventure Requirement 4 - Show how to tie half hitches and a taut-line hitch. Show how to tie a square knot and explain how it is used.

Cooking Safety

Bear	Bear Picnic Basket Requirement 1b– Prepare for cooking by explaining the importance of cooking safety.
Junior	Legacy: Cook – Stay safe, avoid accidents in the kitchen
Cadette	Legacy: Cook – Stay safe, avoid accidents in the kitchen

Bike Safety

Tiger	Rolling Tiger Requirement 2 – With your den or an adult, try on safety gear, show how to wear a bicycle helmet properly.
Tiger	Rolling Tiger Requirement 3 – learn and demonstrate safety tips to follow when riding your bicycle.
Tiger	Rolling Tiger Requirement 4– learn and demonstrate proper hand signals
Tiger	Rolling Tiger Requirement 5 – Do a safety check on your bicycle
Junior	Safety Award – Learn about bicycle safety, learn how to check if a helmet fits you properly and why helmets are important.
