2023 Extension of the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Auburn and VRFA for GIS Services

This agreement is entered into this 31 day of December, 2022, by and between the CITY OF AUBURN, a municipal corporation of the State of Washington, and the VALLEY REGIONAL FIRE AUTHORITY, a regional fire authority of the State of Washington, both of whom are the parties to an interlocal agreement for geographic information systems services.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an interlocal agreement for GIS services on August 7, 2017; and,

WHEREAS, in 2021 the parties amended the agreement through the adoption of Addendum No. One, which addendum amended the term of the agreement to expire on December 31, 2022 and provided for two one-year extension periods upon written agreement of the Parties; and,

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the interlocal agreement for an additional one-year term with all terms remaining unaltered.

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of their mutual covenants, conditions and promises, and pursuant to section seven of the Interlocal Agreement, the parties agree to extend the term of the Interlocal Agreement for a one-year period, which shall begin on 1/1/2023 and terminate on 12/31/2023.
